## Radia's first office block unveiled

Integrated development in Bukit Jelutong suitable for investors looking to relocate to Shah Alam

THE first ever office tower to be developed in Bukit Jelutong, Shah Alam, was recently unveiled in a Shanghai Mid-Autumn-themed soiree.

Block A of Radia Offices is the first of its kind in the area and is the result of a 50:50 joint venture between Sime Darby Property Bhd and UEM Sunrise Bhd.

The office block, projected to be ready by 2018, is a part of the Radia integrated development, which has a gross development value of RM1.6bil.

Block A comprises 159 units of stratified offices with flexible builtup areas ranging from 825sq ft to 2,001sq ft.

The units are suitable for startup companies, SMEs and investors looking to relocate or set up offices in Shah Alam.

The units are going at an estimated average price of RM770 per sq ft.

Klang and Kuala Lumpur."
Block A of Radia Offices is the third and final component to be introduced by the JV partnership since the introduction of Radia in September 2013.

Radia features a retail component with one, two and three-storey retail shops, two blocks of 10-storey offices and five blocks for residences.

Radia is expected to have 880,000sq ft retail spaces, 305,000sq ft office and 640 units of serviced apartments.

Bukit Jelutong is a mature
neighbourhood surrounded by
top-notch facilities and a host of
multi-tiered amenities, including
golf courses, top educational institutions, hypermarket retailers,
shopping malls, hotels and worldclass medical facilities.

"Since the unveiling of the RM1.6bil integrated development, our partnership with Sime Darby Property from the early stage of development has been successful and we are excited to move forward to the next phase.

"We expect to complete the overall project with retail, commercial, office, lifestyle and entertainment centres to fulfil the needs of the Bukit Jelutong community and the wider catchment area of Greater Kuala Lumpur and Klang

Valley," Anwar Syahrin said.

Last year, the JV released three of the five blocks of serviced apartments in Radia Residences with a built-up ranging from 695 sq ft to 2,126 sq ft.

The units come with one bedroom, two bedrooms, 2+1 bedrooms and 3+1 bedrooms and are priced between RM425,000 and RM1,793,000.

Response for the residential component has been encouraging with 84% take-up to-date.

Upon completion, Radia will provide shopping convenience and easy access to services for more than 100,000 residents and working population in Bukit Jelutong and its surrounding areas.

The developers expect Radia to attract investors and businesses which are drawn to Bukit Jelutong's close proximity to outdoor, heritage and recreational offerings.
